

AUSTRALIAN MARIMBA COMPETITION 2022

Information and Rules

General Conditions

The Australian Marimba Competition is international event. The 7th edition of the Australian Marimba Competition will take place online from 1 October to 16 October 2022 under the aegis of the Australian Percussion Academy Pty Ltd

The Competition has 3 age categories or sections and open to percussionists of all nationalities:

Section A - for 18 years of age and over at the 15 September 2022

Section B - for 13 - 17 years of age at the 15 September 2022

Section C - for 12 years of age and under at the 15 September 2022

All members of jury, as well as participants must show full respect to the Australian Marimba Competition (AMC). Any attempt of candidates or misbehavior before and during the AMC can lead to disqualification.

The participants and adjudicators are not allowed to contact each other during competition. All decisions by the international competition jury will be final.

The Competition will be held in 3 Rounds: Round One, Round Two (semi-final) and Round Three (Final).

After Round One 10 competitors from each section will proceed to Round Two.

After Round Two 3 competitors from each section will proceed to the Round Three.

Applications

Deadline for submission of Application Form was by 1 July 2022. Now the time of applying for the AMC were extended to 15 September.

Applications are now closed!

Payment for Registration (Entry fee) should be made via link provided in Application form. Registrations fees:

Section A - \$165 AUD; Section B - \$165 AUD; Section C - \$110 AUD

The Registration fee is not refundable.

To participate in Round One, each competitor must provide the following information and documents:

- A completely filled-in digital Application Form
- A copy of the applicant's passport
- A brief biography in English describing training and achievements
- A recent, high-quality photograph for publicity purposes
- A complete listing of the works intended to be performed during each round of the Competition following the repertoire requirements. The list should specify composer, title, and performance duration of each chosen work.

Each Competitor in Sections B and C must provide before 15 September 2022:

Video link 1 - Round One program (please check maximum duration)

Video link 2 - Round Two program (please check maximum duration)

Video link of Round 3 can be submitted by 1 October 2022.

Each Competitor in Section A must provide before 28 September 2022:

Video link 1 - Round One program (please check maximum duration)

Video link 2 - Round Two program (please check maximum duration)

Video link of Round 3 can be submitted by 7 October 2022.

Each Round-video must be submitted as YouTube link, available for public view and subtitled as follows:

AMC 2022 / FULL NAME of participant / Round / Section

Composer – Name of piece/pieces

It's not allowed to use past concert video recordings and past videos posted on YouTube.

Each competition round needs to be performed and recorded in one session, in one take, without editing and cuts. The recording must be recorded in real time and should not have been edited or altered in any way. The Organising Committee of the Australian Marimba Competition reserves the right to disqualify candidates who have submitted studio enhanced or modified recordings and paid Registration Fee will not be refunded.
